Hours

Most of our trips are provided from 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. We are closed on most major holidays. Please call at least 24 hours in advance to schedule a local ride and 48 hours in advance for a trip to Pueblo or Raton, NM.

Policies

- Eating or drinking on the bus is prohibited.
- Service animals may accompany a passenger, but must be leashed or in a pet carrier.
- All passengers must use seatbelts.
- A certified personal care attendant may ride for free.
- SCCOG Transit is a shared-ride service, meaning more than one passenger may be scheduled during the time you ride.
- Three no-shows in one month will result in a 10 day suspension. A no-show occurs when the passenger is not available when the driver arrives for pickup, or when the passenger calls dispatch to cancel a trip less than one hour before the driver arrives.
- Bus drivers cannot assist passengers in wheelchairs up or down steps, or clear a path to the vehicle obstructed by ice, snow or other physical barrier.
